Childhood hunger is a nearly invisible problem but exists in every community in America, including our own! 1 in 5 children struggles with food insecurity in the U.S.

FACTS

- Started in Dover, NH in 2011.
- Currently 40 chapters worldwide.
- The Wolfeboro chapter began August 2014 serving 18 children.
- GWRSD currently serves 135 students.
- The program runs for 10 months while school is in session that serves all 41 weekends.
- Each weekend each child is sent home with 2 breakfast meals, 2 lunches, 3 dinners, and snacks.
- Each bag prepared costs about \$12.
- Currently 40+ volunteers in the Wolfeboro chapter.

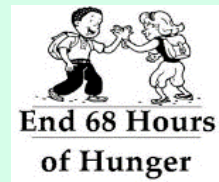

- Pork & Beans: 11 oz.
- Applesauce Cups: Individual
