The "National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2010", Public Law 111-84, permits the use of unused sick leave for service credit in the computation of retirement annuity under FERS. Employees will receive service credit for their unused sick leave. Effective January 1, 2014, employees will receive service credit for 100 percent of their unused sick leave. The addition of unused sick leave will be added to your actual years, months and days of service in the computation of your retirement annuity you will receive.												
The collective bargaining agreements for the following bargaining units contain provisions which authorizes retiring FERS employees with an option payment of 40 percent of the value of their accumulated sick leave:
