This is an update to the notice we previously issued.

Effective Tuesday, March 24th at noon, our physical office will be closed to foot traffic in accordance with the order issued today by Governor Baker.

We are considered essential and will remain working both in the office and from home for the next two weeks.

You can drop your tax documents through the mail slot in our door or send your documents in electronically. Our electronic delivery of tax documents, returns and e-signatures to sign transmittals will remain active.

If you have not already done so, please contact one of us to coordinate the preparation of your tax return.

The Internal Revenue Service has now extended the filing deadline to July 15th for all taxpayers businesses and individuals. **At this time, this relief only applies to federal income taxes. There has been no official word from Massachusetts regarding the extension of the tax deadline. In addition, other states have not issued formal extensions and those that have may not coincide with the IRS extension.**

This situation is constantly changing and we will keep you posted regarding any additional changes that may alter this information.
