From the North

- Take I-93S towards Boston
- Take exit 20A towards South Station – you will be inside the central artery tunnel at this point
- Take immediate RIGHT onto Summer Street
- Take immediate RIGHT onto High Street
- Take immediate LEFT onto Federal Street
- 101 Federal Street is on the LEFT

From the South

- Take I-93N towards Boston
- Take EXIT 20 (South Station – 90 – Logan Airport – Worcester): bear off to the RIGHT and go under an overpass, eventually bearing left towards “South Station / Chinatown”
- Stay in the center lane so you can GO STRAIGHT onto Lincoln Street at second light by crossing over Kneeland Street.
- At the end of Lincoln Street turn RIGHT onto Summer Street
- Take immediate LEFT onto High Street at traffic light
- Take immediate LEFT onto Federal Street
- 101 Federal Street is on the left

From Massachusetts Turnpike (I-90)

- Follow signs for EXIT 24A-B (South Station / North 93 / Concord, NH)
- Take EXIT 24A (South Station) by bearing right
- The 24A ramp eventually splits – stay left towards Chinatown and Atlantic Avenue
- At the set of lights at the bottom of the ramp take a LEFT on Kneeland Street
- Turn RIGHT on Lincoln Street at your next light
- At the end of Lincoln Street turn RIGHT onto Summer Street
- Take immediate LEFT onto High Street at traffic light
- Take immediate LEFT onto Federal Street
- 101 Federal Street is on the left

Validated Parking: Garage entrance is on the LEFT as you drive down Federal St. Sign reads “75-101 Parking” and entrance is just before our building. Take elevator to lobby and then look for that elevator bank marked “101 Federal Elevators Floors 3-15”. We are on the 8th floor. Occasionally, the garage is full but you should be able to talk your way in by telling the valet you will be here for just one hour.

Via Public Transportation

Our office is steps from the Red (South Station), Orange (Downtown Crossing) and Green (Park Street) lines.
