

## BFC PLANNING, INC. BUSINESS CONTINUITY DISCLOSURE PLAN SUMMARY

BFC Planning, Inc. ("BFC") has developed a Business Continuity Plan on how we will respond to events that significantly disrupt our business. Since the timing and impact of disasters and disruptions is unpredictable, we will have to be flexible in responding to actual events as they occur. With that in mind, we are providing you with this information on our business continuity plan.

<u>Contacting Us –</u> Your primary contact should always be your Financial Professional. However, if you need to contact us during or after a significant business disruption, you should first call (888) 202-2326. If you cannot reach us at that number, you should call our alternate number at (800) 356-5234 or go to our website at www.berthel.com. Additionally, you may access your account information directly by contacting the custodian using the contact information on your statement.

<u>Our Business Continuity Plan</u> – We plan to quickly recover and resume business operations after a significant business disruption and respond by safeguarding our employees and property, making a financial and operational assessment, protecting the firm's books and records, and allowing our customers to transact business. In short, our business continuity plan is designed to permit our firm to resume operations as quickly as possible, given the scope and severity of the significant business disruption.

Our business continuity plan addresses: data backup and recovery; all mission critical systems; financial and operational assessments; alternative communications with customers, employees, and regulators; alternative physical location of employees; critical supplier, contractor, bank and counter-party impact; regulatory reporting; and assuring our customers prompt access to their funds and securities if we are unable to continue our business.

Our custodians back up our important records in a geographically separate area. While every emergency situation poses unique problems based on external factors, such as time of day and the severity of the disruption, we have been advised by our custodians that their objective is to restore their operations and be able to complete existing transactions and accept new transactions and payments within approximately four hours. Your orders and requests for funds and securities could be delayed during this period.

BFC Financial Professionals may or may not be affected by any business disruption that affects the corporate office depending on their location. Similarly, depending upon the custodian and its geographic location, it may or may not be affected by a business disruption that affects the corporate office. Conversely, a disruption may affect your Financial Professional or custodian, but not the corporate office. The contact information provided above should help you determine alternative means of communication regardless of the disruption or area of business affected.

<u>Varying Disruptions</u> – Significant business disruptions can vary in their scope, such as only our corporate office, a single building housing our firm, the business district where our firm is located, the city where we are located, or the whole region. Within each of these areas, the severity of the disruption can also vary from minimal to severe. In a disruption to only our corporate office or a building housing our corporate office, we will transfer our operations to a local site when needed and expect to recover and resume business within a reasonable time. In a disruption affecting our business district, city, or region, we will transfer our operations to a site outside the affected area and recover and resume business within a reasonable time. In either situation, we plan to continue in business, re-route telephone calls if necessary to an alternate phone number, and/or notify you through our website www.berthel.com how to contact us. If the significant business disruption is so severe that it prevents us from remaining in business, we will assure our customers' prompt access to their funds and securities.
