


To access, view, and respond all the recipient has to do is click on **View Message** on any device with a modern web browser and they will be taken to the message.



The recipient will need to enroll in the **ExchangeDefender** service and provide the following information. This information is required for legal and security purposes. Once the user has identified themselves and set their **password** and **four-digit** PIN the account is officially enrolled and locked down with personally identifiable information no other individual or organization is aware of. These credentials are used to further encrypt and secure the message transfer. They are also used to eliminate the possibility of a man-in-the-middle attack, to keep out the IT department rogue personnel that may be reading emails without authorization, or anyone that has access to recipients' email.

After they complete the process, they will be taken to the message.
