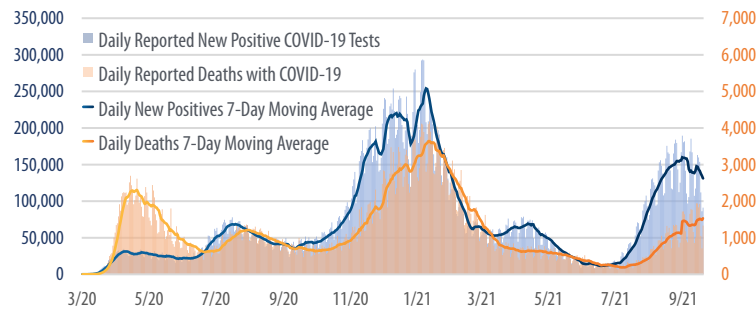

March 1, 2020 - September 27, 2021



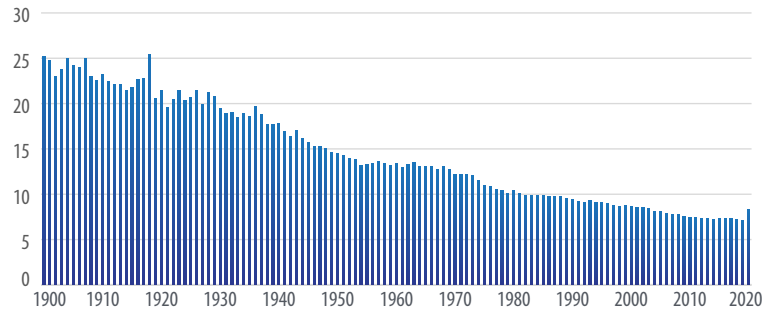
Concern About Getting COVID-19 Among Vaccinated and Unvaccinated Individuals

U.S. Age-Adjusted Deaths per 1,000

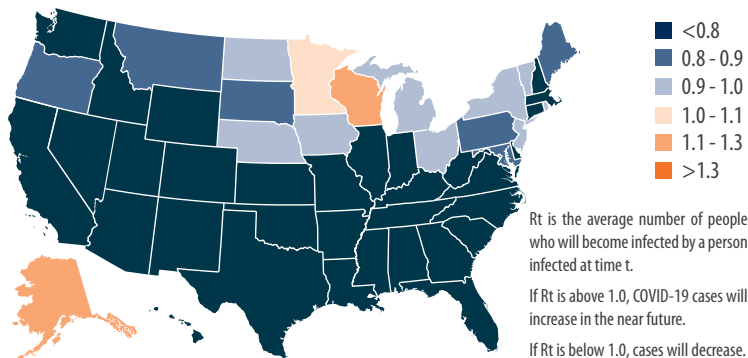

A recent Harris Poll found that **one-third (33%) of vaccinated Americans reported cutting ties in some way with friends, family members, or acquaintances who remain unvaccinated. 47% of Gen Z respondents, 53% of Millennials, 31% of Gen X and 18% of Baby Boomers had cut ties.**²

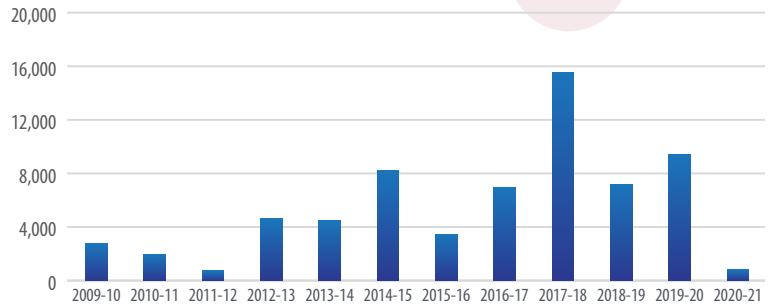
Effective Reproduction Number (Rt) of COVID-19 by State

As of September 27, 2021



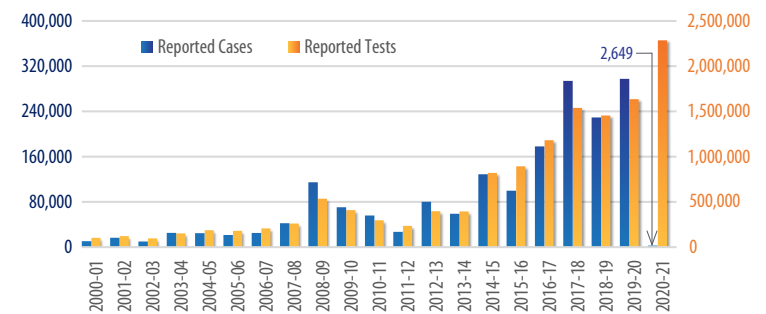
U.S. Reported Influenza Deaths

As of September 18, 2021



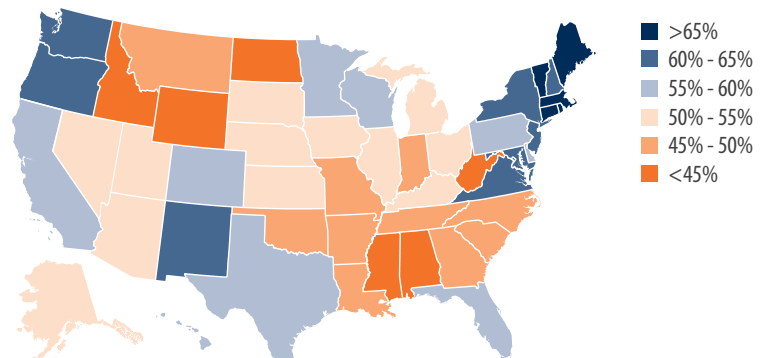
U.S. Influenza Reported Tests vs Reported Cases

An analysis conducted by the CDC found that **nearly 71% of adults surveyed that tested positive for COVID-19 reported they "always" used a cloth face covering or mask in public vs. 74% of adults surveyed that tested negative.**¹
