MMHS is a 24 hours a day 7 days a week facility and without this influx of income we would have to close during the day from 8 am to 4pm like the other urban shelters. We have support staff to work on housing and employment during the daytime, 67% of our guests secure employment while working with our employment program and 97% of those families and single adults that we have housed in the last 3 years are still stably housed, " it is awesome to experience people rebuilding lives" said Betty Palmer, Executive Director.
