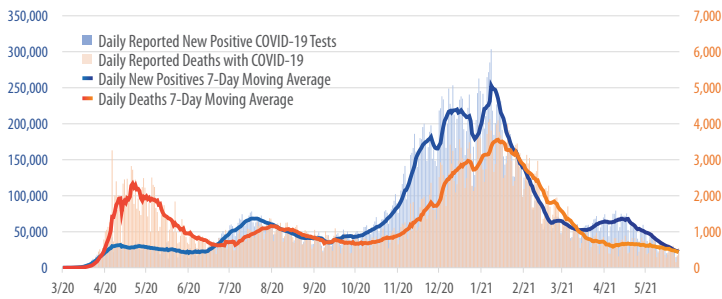

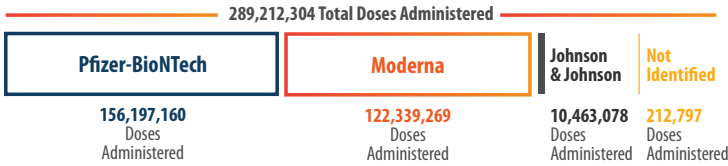
Daily Reported New Positive COVID-19 Tests vs. Daily Reported Deaths from COVID-19 in the U.S.

March 1, 2020 - May 25, 2021



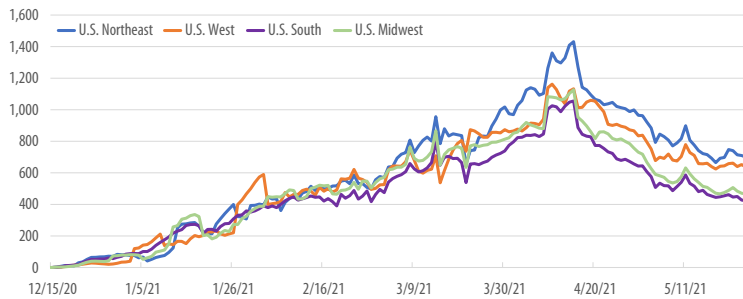
U.S. COVID-19 Vaccine Doses Administered by Vaccine Type

December 15, 2020 - May 25, 2021

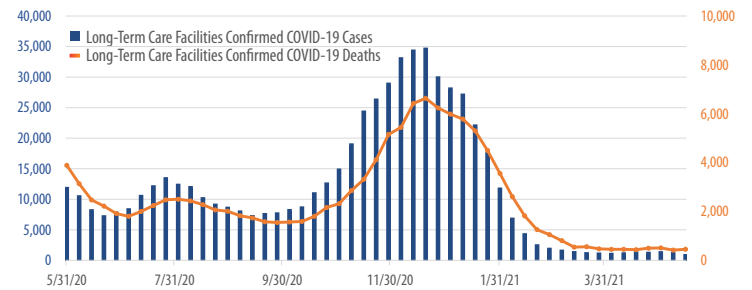


As of May 25, 2021, the 7-day moving average for COVID-19 deaths was 435, the lowest since March 30, 2020.

Deaths on a 7-day moving average over the entire pandemic have only been lower 29 other days, all in March 2020 when the virus first took off.¹

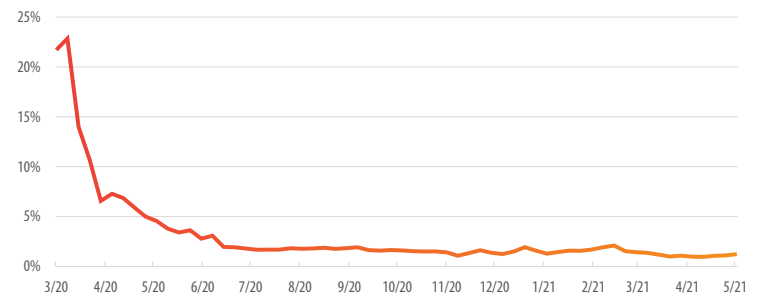
Cases and Deaths by Week in U.S. Long-Term Care Facilities

U.S. Case Fatality Ratio

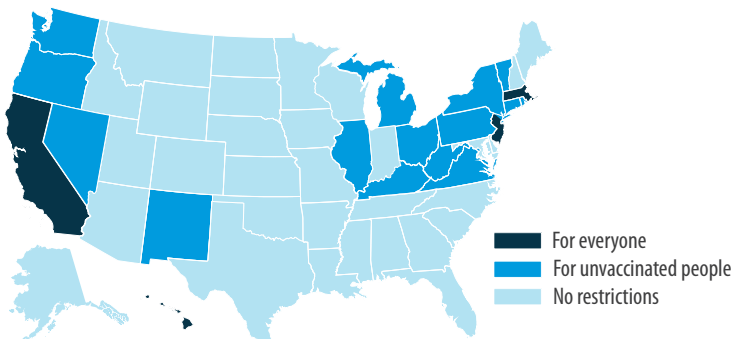
March 22, 2020 - May 23, 2021



So far, 23 states have announced they will end the federal pandemic unemployment assistance programs before their September 6th expiration. That makes up 40.7% of the labor force and 34.1% of the total unemployed. Montana, Arizona, New Hampshire and Oklahoma have also introduced back-to-work incentives using federal relief money for the first X amount of eligible applicants who get a job and keep it for X amount of weeks (bonuses ranging \$500-\$2000).²

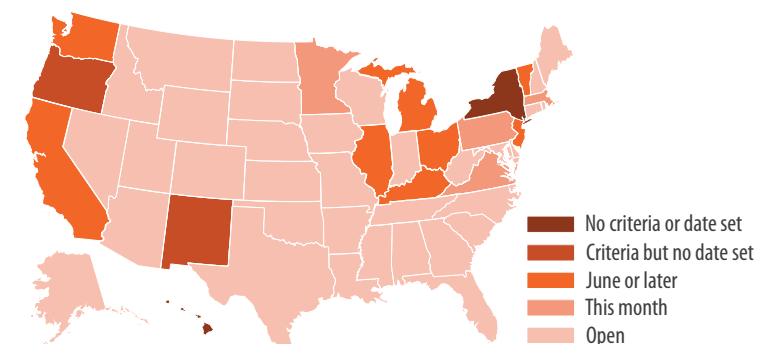
Where Masks are Required Indoors
