



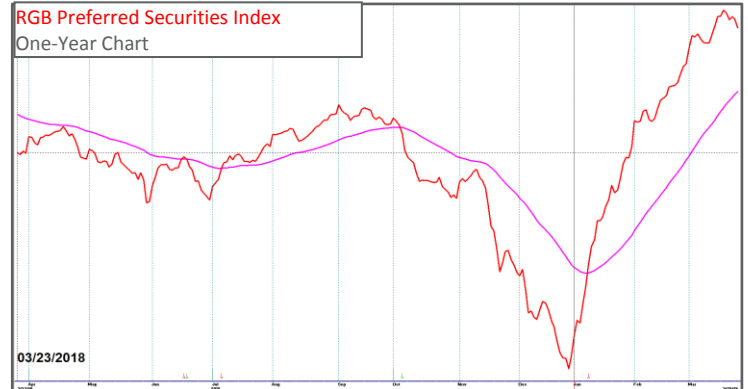
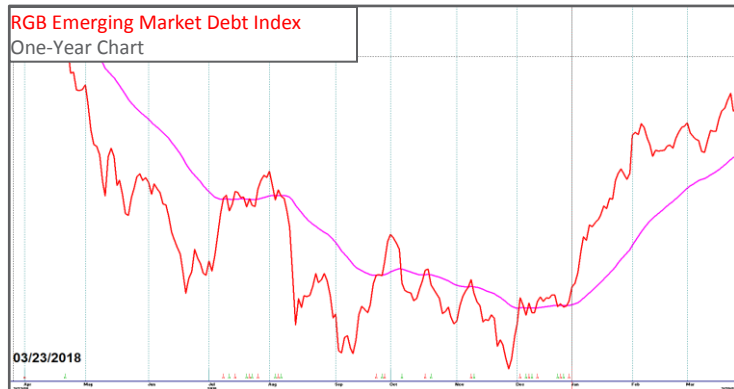
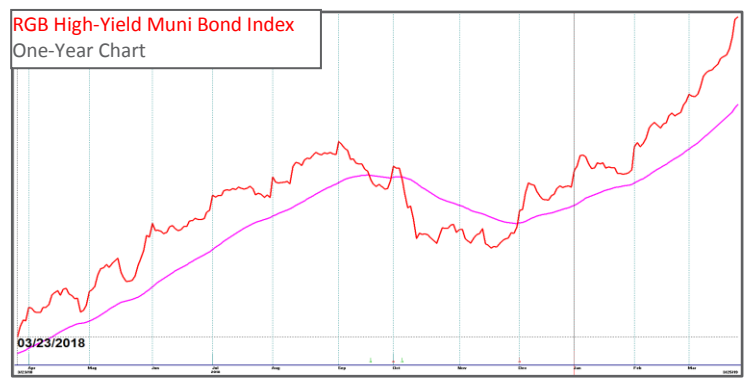
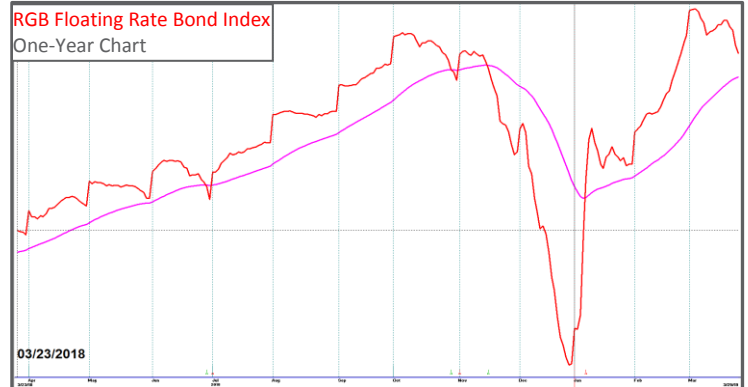
# RGB Perspectives
