## Bask in the illumination of the fine works of LINDA JARVIS and SHANE MILLER

These two artists unite in friendship and creativity. Their works compliment each other's so well, it was intuitively decided that they exhibit their work as one body.

LINDA JARVIS - The Folkart of the Earth assemblages that Linda Jarvis creates are derived from elements she finds in nature, or in a junk shop, a parking lot, or street where humankind has discarded items that delight her artistic eye. Within these arrangements she often unites the found treasures with her drawings and illustrations of creatures of the wild. She has a profound adoration of nature and her reverence is revealed through her illustrations.

Each finished assemblage has it's own sensibility or sentiment and emotion which imparts a sense of energy in it's totality. All the elements expressed together generate a relationship, and part of that relationship is Linda's participation with those elements. As she states, "I experience each element for it's color, shape, texture and force. There is a collaboration that takes place and I become embraced in their influence".

**SHANE MILLER** - The inner glow that is emitted from Shane Miller's elegantly crafted lamps is that of warmth and comfort. She says, "If a house represents comfort, shelter, and protection then the light within is surely the soul. These lamps, created of paper, imagery, and light, are like a touchstone reminding us of nurturing and being nurtured".

The lamps are a combination of photo etchings on paper, wood, mica, and copper and are wired for 110 volts. The photographs she employs are those she has taken herself or are old photos she finds from various resources. They are then etched on to paper using a non-toxic intaglio printmaking technique. Each piece creates a mood for beautiful ambiant lighting.
