Investment Statements

If you have an investment account *not held at Niehaus Financial*, please bring a copy of a recent statement showing investment details (names of securities, values, cost basis if applicable).

For employer retirement plans (401k, 403b, etc.), include a list of available investment options.

Bank Account Information

List balances and interest rates of checking, savings, and CDs (note maturity dates).

Debt Information

If applicable, list the balance remaining on your mortgage and any other outstanding loans, as well as the interest rate for each.

Social Security Benefit Statement / Pension Benefit Statement

If you are not already receiving benefits, provide the most recent projection of what you will receive. For Social Security, statements are now available online at www.ssa.gov or you may call 1-800-772-1213.

Tax Return

If we do not already have a copy of your most recent tax return, please provide a copy of pages 1 & 2 of your 1040 and Schedules A & D, if applicable.
