

Things are moving quickly over at 110 Main Street! Here are some of the highlights of what has been accomplished so far:

- Demo is 100% complete including HVAC and most plumbing
- Floor leveling complete
- Layout for new plumbing started
- HVAC rough ins started
- Wall framing on 1st & 2nd floors started
- Electrical rough ins started
- Additional sign added to front of building
- Concrete deck on second floor has been poured and second floor is completely filled in
- More natural light is filling the space

When are you moving back in?


As of now, we are on target to move back in early/mid September 2023. This is subject to change, but we will keep you updated as we know more.

Did You Know??



Many changes to individual income taxes in the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017 are scheduled to 'sunset' at the end of 2025 unless additional congressional action is taken. This could mean tax increases for many individuals. 2026 will be here soon!

Indiana's 20% maximum tax credit for 529 contributions has been increased from \$1,000 to \$1,500 (meaning you can now get a 20% credit on contributions up to \$7,500 in 2023).

Medicare Part B and Part D premiums are based on your income from 2 years ago.
