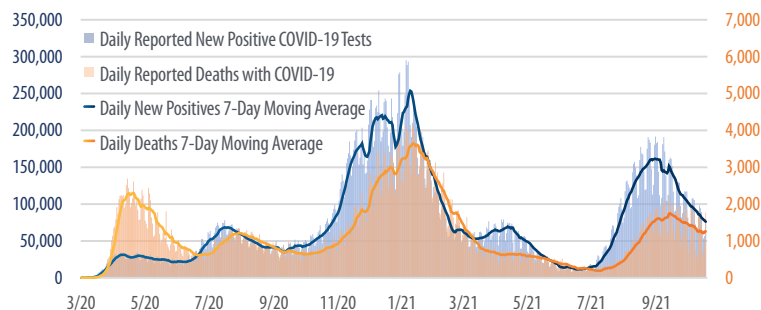

## Daily Reported New Positive COVID-19 Tests vs. Daily Reported Deaths from COVID-19 in the U.S.

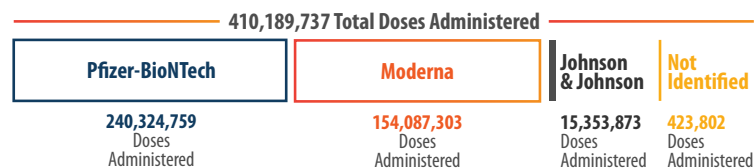

## U.S. COVID-19 Vaccine Doses Administered by Vaccine Type

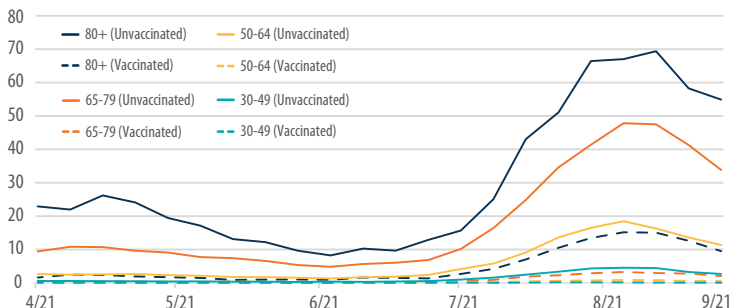

April 10, 2021 - September 4, 2021

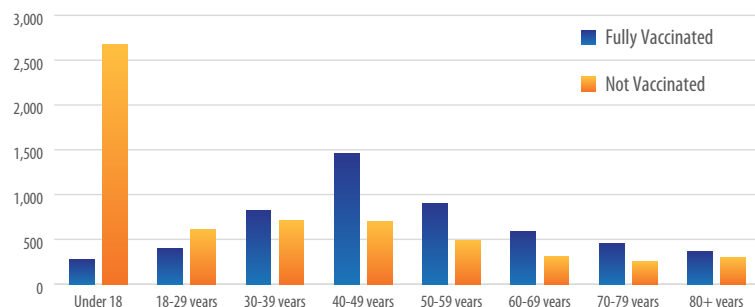

According to a September 2021 poll from the Kaiser Family Foundation, **34% of parents with a child between 5 and 11 years old say they will vaccinate their child right away once a vaccine is available for their age group**, compared to **32% who say they will wait and see**, **7% who will only if required**, and **24% that will definitely not**.

## UK COVID-19 Case Rate per 100k by Vaccine Status

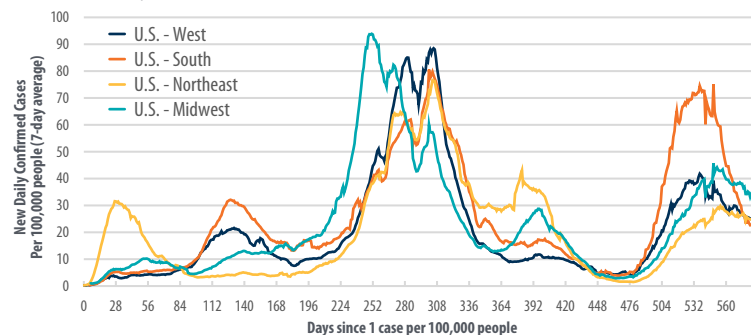

## Daily Reported COVID-19 Cases by U.S. Regions, Normalized by Population

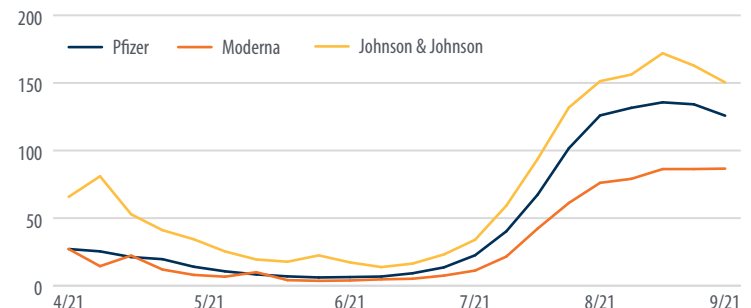

## U.S. COVID-19 Case Rate per 100k in Population by Vaccine Product

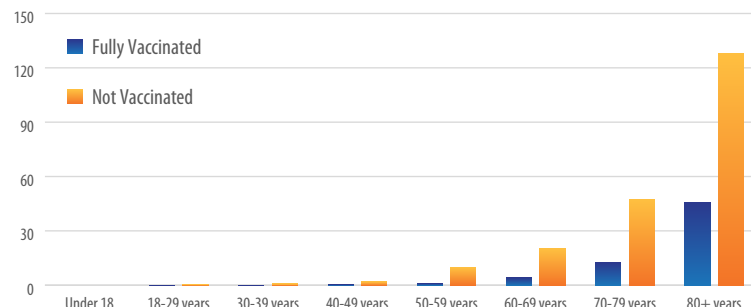
April 10, 2021 - September 4, 2021

Wall Street firms shed more New York City jobs during the Covid-19 pandemic in 2020 than any year since the 2008 recession, according to a report released Thursday, October 21, 2021. **New York City's share of jobs in the securities field fell in 2020 to a three-decade low of 18%, down from 33% in 1990.**<sup>1</sup>
