| ☐ Check smoke detectors | ☐ Check air conditioning unit |
| ☐ Check fire extinguishers | ☐ Check basement for dampness and insects |
| \square Check carbon monoxide detectors | $\ \square$ Check for leaky faucets, clogged drains and sweaty pipes |
| ☐ Replace furnace filter | \square Look for warped, loose or splintered boards on deck |
| ☐ Perform exterior home inspection | ☐ Wash off outdoor furniture |
| ≪ FALL MAINTENANCE: | |
| ☐ Inspect weather stripping, apply caulking if needed | ☐ Have chimney inspected and cleaned, close/open dampers |
| ☐ Inspect doors/windows for air tightness | ☐ Check plumbing for leaks |
| \square Clean gutters, inspect roof shingles/flashing | ☐ Blow sprinklers and internal water pipes |
| \square Check/seal cracks/leaks in foundation and walls | ☐ Shut off main water supply |
| \square Check attic/basement for signs of moisture | Apply antifreeze where needed |
| ☐ Prune trees and bushes | ☐ Clean lint from dryer and dryer area |
| $\hfill \square$ Store firewood away from home to avoid infestations | ☐ Clean, cover, store outdoor furniture |
| ☐ Clean AC condenser coils and change filters | ☐ Have pool winterized |
| ☐ Consider programmable thermostat | ☐ Store chemicals per manufactures instructions |
| ☐ Remove flammable material from any heat source | ☐ Replace furnace filter |
